Read Joshua 1:1-2

The death of Moses was one of the most pivotal moments of transition in the life of Israel. In your own life, what would you say was one of the biggest turning points? How did it feel?

God left no marker on Moses' grave, seemingly wanting the people to move on. How can we tell when we are grieving a loss in a healthy way vs. grave-tending and getting stuck in the past?

In the book of Joshua, God takes his people to a place they've never been under leadership they've never followed. What do you think gave them courage to do what they had not been able to do under Moses?

Is there a step of faith right now that you see God asking you to take? Do you feel hesitant? If so, can you name why?

Read Isaiah 43:18-19. What do you think might be some "former things" God would have you leave behind? What new things can you identify him growing in your life?
