Read Joshua 7

What aspects of this story do you find troubling? What questions does it raise for you?

Achan had something he had literally buried that needed to be brought into the light. Have you ever had that kind of experience? What was the feeling when you finally came clean?

Read Daniel 9 and Romans 5 in light of this passage. What stands out to you about the corporate nature about sin? What troubles you about it?

Jesus suffering our punishment as the Innocent One puts him squarely in the shoes of Achan's children in this story. Does it make any difference in the way you read this story to think of Jesus as a fellow sufferer who asked where God was in his greatest moment of need?

The Valley of Achor means "Trouble Valley." What is troubling you most right now? Spend some time asking Christ to show you how he is with you in the "valley of the shadow."
