### **Read Joshua 14:6-14, Numbers 13 & 14**

When Caleb went to explore the Promised Land with the other spies, he saw the extent of the goodness as well as the obstacles to occupying it. What do you see in your life as the biggest obstacles to receiving God's promises?

List out as many promises of God as you can that you believe apply to you. Which of them is the most difficult to believe? Why is that?

As Caleb waited 45 years to receive his land, he learned that part of God's promise was being fulfilled in the waiting as God kept him alive. Can you think of a promise in your own life that took on new meaning as you waited for it?

Caleb asked for hill country right in the heart of where the most intimidating enemies live. What hill country would you like to ask God for?

Someone said, "Do something every day that scares you." What is one small action step of courage you'd like to take? Ask God to help you face that fear.
