### **Read Joshua 1:1-9**

Compare these verse with Deuteronomy 31:7-8. Why do you think Joshua needed to hear the message "Be strong and courageous" so many times when Moses apparently did not?

What do you see as the difference between being strong and having courage?

This theme of strength and courage runs through much of Joshua's life. When you look back at your own history, what do you see as a consistent thread in your relationship with God? How does that impact the way you think of the future?

In verse 3, God indicates he will give Joshua everywhere his foot lands. Does that shape how you think about "being in God's will?" How so? (See also Proverbs 16:3, Isaiah 30:21, Colossians 3:23)

What is one area of your life where it is difficult to be strong and courageous right now? Ask God to meet you there.
