Read Joshua 2

The chapter is centered around Rahab's confession of faith. Summarize the main points of what she was saying. If you were to come up with something of the same length to express your faith in God, what would you say?

In trusting God, Rahab had to make a break with her community and the voices of authority she had lived with up until this point. Can you think of a powerful force in your own life that you have had to separate from to follow God? Are there any you're discovering now?

After the spies left, Rahab had a time of waiting where she had to count on the promises made being true. What promises of God do you feel you are needing to trust are true right now?

Christians see the scarlet rope as a picture of Christ and his blood shed for us. How does that imagery speak to you and the way you think about salvation?

Rahab was greatly concerned that her family and loved ones were included when her life was spared. Take some time to pray for someone you'd love to see God rescue.
