Read Joshua 4:4-4:9

Can you think of other examples where God asked his people to remember? Why do you think we are prone to forget?

What is a specific example of a time God has "met you in the river" and intervened? Have you ever had the opportunity to see that memory used as a testimony?

Do you find the concept of witnessing or sharing faith anxiety-producing? Does it change anything to frame it as simply telling your own story? Why or why not?

Read and reflect on Psalm 77. What stands out to you? The writer was going through a time when God didn't seem to be answering, so his strategy was to remember God's deeds from the past. What do you think of that strategy?

God is not only interested in rescuing us out of our situation; he wants to redeem it for his glory. What is a current circumstance you can pray to him about?
