Read Joshua 5:10-12 & Exodus 16

Can you think of an example from your own life of a time God provided for you in an unexpected way? What stayed with you from that experience?

Even after the miraculous rescue in crossing the Red Sea, the people still seemed to doubt God could take care of them in the desert. Why do you think we so quickly forget God's power and love?

Read Psalm 78:13-39. What stands out to you about God's mercy in the face of ongoing rebellion?

God stopped providing manna when the Israelites reached the Promised Land. He still provided for them there -- just in a different way. Has it ever felt like God changed up how he was providing for you? How did that impact your expectations?

The Israelites had to think about feeding themselves differently in the new context. What is one way you feel God may be calling you to be more proactive in feeding yourself spiritually?
