Read Mark 16:9-20

Mark gives very little detail about Mary Magdalene's experience or that of the two on the road to Emmaus. What hint does that give us about where his attention was focused?

Read verse 16. The word disbelieve is a strong word meaning a refusal to believe. How does it change the way you read this section to realize that the same word was used of the disciples in verse 14?

Jesus indicates some very sensational signs will accompany faith. How do you interpret those verses and what are we to make of them today?

Notice in verse 15 where Jesus says to preach the gospel to every creature. What do you think it means to include the entire created order in our declaration of the gospel?

The great commission as stated here is arguably one of Jesus' most important charges to his followers. How does this apply to the majority of Christians today who don't consider themselves preachers? How do you read it for yourself?
