Read Mark 1:1-8, Exodus 23:20, Isaiah 40:3-5, Malachi 3:1

Kristi McLelland observed that we typically want to get out of our wilderness, when perhaps we should be asking how we can carry it with us into the future. What do you think of that statement?

John the Baptist was clear about who he was and who he wasn't. When do you find it most difficult to hang on to that distinction?
