Read Nehemiah 6

After reading this chapter, compare Nehemiah's experience to that of Jesus in Matthew 4:1-11. Do you see any parallels in the attacks of Sanballat and the attacks of Satan on Jesus?

The invitations the enemies were sending to Nehemiah seemed innocuous enough, but Nehemiah saw them as a sinful distraction. Do you find yourself struggling with distractions? In what way?

Nehemiah prayed for God to strengthen his hands (verse 9). Has God ever done that for you? In what way?

What is one area where you would like God to give you strength right now?

Look at Paul's thinking on weakness in 1 Corinthians 1:27-31 and 2 Corinthians 12:7-10. Reflect on how this fits in with what we learn in Nehemiah 6:16. What weakness of your own could you offer to God for his glory?
