Read Philippians 3:1-9

Paul starts this section off by saying "Rejoice in the Lord." How do you think that relates to where he goes with his line of thought?

Compare this section with Galatians 3. How does that chapter illuminate Paul's words to the Philippians?

How can we differentiate between being "under the law" and living a godly life? Is there a practical difference?

Can you think of any area where you place confidence other than Christ? What would it look and feel like to transfer that trust to Christ the way Paul did? What makes that difficult?

Do you struggle more with self-reliance or shame? How can those be flip sides of the same coin?
